To qualify for services under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA) as a "youth," an individual must meet all of the criteria stated below:

- Is not less than age 14 and not more than 21;
- Low income individual;
- An individual who is in one or more of the following categories:
 - Deficient in basic literacy skills;
 - A school dropout;
 - Homeless, a runaway, or a foster child;
 - Pregnant or parenting;
 - An offender;
 - An individual (including a youth with a disability) who requires additional assistance to complete an education program, or to secure and hold employment.
