  - (A) Deficient in basic literacy skills;**
  - (B) School Dropout;**
  - (C) Homeless, runaway, or foster child;**
  - (D) Pregnant or parenting;**
  - (E) Offender; or**
  - (F) An individual (including a youth with a disability) who requires additional assistance to complete an education program, or to secure and hold employment.**
